



2020-2021 IN-STUDIO PROTOCOL & PROCEDURES

ARRIVAL

Students should be dropped off by a parent no more than 15 minutes prior to the start of class. Students shall maintain appropriate social distancing while waiting for entry into the building (sidewalks are marked accordingly). Students must wear a face mask at all times when entering the building, inside the building or exiting the building. Students will be called into the building one at a time to have their temperature checked. Students who have a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be permitted to take class. Once students are approved to enter the building, they will be given hand sanitizer before being directed to the appropriate studio. Parents should wait to ensure that their child has been approved to enter the building before leaving the parking lot.

WHAT TO BRING

Students may only bring the following:

1. One dance bag that contains all items listed below. (Students will not be permitted to bring multiple bags unless permission has been granted by the Director.)
2. A water bottle. Water fountains will be permitted to use for refilling bottles only..
3. A small bottle of hand sanitizer
4. A cell phone (which must be on silent.)

ENTERING & EXITING THE DANCE ROOM

Once a student has been permitted to enter the building, they will remove their street shoes and place their dance bag in a designated area prior to entering the dance room. Students will only take their water bottle and appropriate dance shoes for the evening into the dance room, and place those items on the designated area of their "box" (marked by an X). Students will put on the appropriate shoes for that class at that time. At the end of class students shall remove their dance shoes, and will exit the dance room one at a time to retrieve their belongings and then move to the exit of the studio one at a time. See details about which exit students will be using under "Drop Off & Pick Up"

FACE MASK PROTOCOL

Students must keep their face mask on at all times when entering the building, during class and when exiting the building.

DROP OFF & PICK UP

No parents, siblings, or other family members will be allowed in the building at any time. To avoid a gathering of many students, parents should drop off students no more than 15 minutes before class time and should be at the studio promptly when a student's class ends to ensure a smooth and quick pick up.

- DROP OFF: When your child is arriving for class they will enter through the main entrance, which is located at the SIDE of the building.
- PICK UP FROM STUDIO 1: At the end of class, your child will be exiting at the BACK of the building.
- PICK UP FROM STUDIO 2: At the end of class, your child will be exiting at the FRONT of the building.

We will have staff in place to ensure safe departure from the studio. Please reference the parent portal to find out from which studio/ dance room your child will be exiting.

OTHER INFO

- Hand sanitizer will be available for use in the lobby and in each studio. Students are encouraged to use as much as needed and are encouraged to wash hands frequently as well.
- Appropriate social distancing as recommended by the CDC will be maintained at all times between students and staff. Students will remain in their designated box throughout class. Faculty will not be touching students at any time (only giving verbal cues & corrections). Faculty will rotate studios as needed, so students can remain in one place throughout the evening.
- Momentum Dance Center is following all CDC guidelines for cleaning and disinfecting daily. In addition to a full cleaning of the building that will be done each day, MDC staff will assist in cleaning between classes as well.

IF A STUDENT BECOMES SICK

If a student becomes symptomatic while in the building, the student will be moved to a predetermined isolated location and parents will be contacted immediately.

IF THERE IS A POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE

All current Momentum families will be notified via email if an individual tests positive for COVID-19. Furthermore, students who may have come into close contact with an individual that tests positive will be notified. (The CDC defines "close contact" as being within 6 feet of an infected person for a prolonged period of time without proper PPE.) Momentum Dance Center will notify and work with local health officials to determine an appropriate course of action. If needed, all in-studio classes may be suspended at which time all classes will continue virtually. Any student that is symptomatic will not be permitted to return to class until they have shown and tested negative or have appropriately quarantined.
